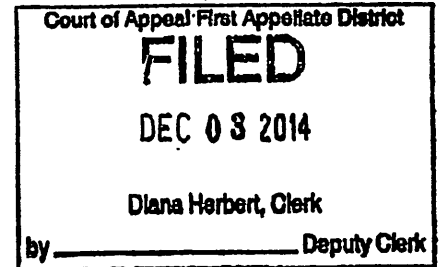

The petition for a writ of review is granted. The matter will be heard before Division One of this court. The clerk of this court need not issue a formal writ in this proceeding.

Unless a party serves and files an objection in writing on or before **December 12, 2014**, the exhibits submitted by the parties will be considered the record under review and the Board need not file a return to the writ. However, if one or more of the parties objects to this procedure, and such objection is timely filed and served, this court will proceed to set a date for the Board to certify and return the record of the proceedings below for further review by the court.

Before reaching a decision, the justices will have fully considered the record and the briefs. Accordingly, the parties should not use oral argument to repeat points made in the briefs. But if oral argument is requested, the request must be filed electronically on or before **December 15, 2014**, using the "Request for Oral Argument" form at <http://www.courts.ca.gov/9261.htm> under "Electronic Filing/Submissions." If no such request is timely submitted, oral argument will be deemed waived. If any party files a timely request for oral argument, the matter will be heard before Division One of this Court in its courtroom on the Fourth Floor of the Earl Warren State Building at 350 McAllister Street, San Francisco, California, at a time and date to be determined.
